

ORDINANCE NO. 8789

AN ORDINANCE OF THE SUPERVISORS OF TAYLOR TOWNSHIP PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF PARKING WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Taylor Township, Blair County, Pennsylvania, assembled, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same that in pursuance of the authority granted to said Township Supervisors under the Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 81, §1; 75 Pa. Stat. Annot. §6109:

SECTION 1: It is hereby ordained that the Supervisors of Taylor Township may regulate the privilege of parking within the Township as necessary for the orderly movement and disposition of travel within the Township and may designate a "No Parking" zone on any street or roadway in the Township when the Supervisors deem it necessary in the best interests of the residents of the Township.

SECTION 2: No person shall park any motor vehicle on any traveled portion of any highway within the Township of Taylor, and when parking any motor vehicle, persons shall park at least two (2) feet away from the traveled portion of the street or highway within the Township of Taylor.

SECTION 3: A law enforcement officer of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or any other person designated by the Supervisors of Taylor Township is hereby authorized to place a ticket upon any motor vehicle in violation of this Ordinance and to assess a parking fine not exceeding Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars for which the owner and operator of such motor vehicle shall be liable, and in default of payment of said parking ticket within seven (7) days after the issuance thereof, the owner and

operator shall, upon conviction thereof before any magistrate in a proceeding commenced by Complaint, warrant or summons, be fined the said sum not exceeding Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars, plus costs of prosecution.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED as an Ordinance of the Township of Taylor, Blair County, Pennsylvania, this 7th day of August, 1989.
